The club will not be responsible for any PayPal fees. Fees for all entries must be received by the start of the show. Cash accepted at door. Uncollectable checks accessed an additional \$50 fee.

All entries must be at least 4 months old; all household pet entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number (TRN).

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies and that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. At show time, we will follow all current CFA COVID policies and Ohio health mandates.

Benching: will be from 7:30 to 8:30 on Saturday and Sunday with judging to start at 9:am. Any cat(s) not checked in by 8:30 will be marked absent. No refunds for failure to bench. Benching cage size is 22x22x22. Litter provided, bring own pans.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), Agility, registered Kittens, registered Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards.

Rosettes will be awarded per CFA rules. Permanent flats will be used - cloth ribbons available.

Miscellaneous: People food will be available. There is no watchman on duty Saturday night. Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers but will not be responsible for damage or loss. This is a NON-SMOKING facility. Smoking of any kind (including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, e-cigarettes and vaping) is not permitted.
